

Stage 5 The Corner of Concern

RULES: 2017 IDPA Rules

COURSE DESIGNER: Roy Bejsovec

START POSITION:

Hands on shoulders of Non-threat

SCENARIO:

You are out for an evening walk and cross the street at a corner. A teenager runs up to you screaming for help. As you try to get the teen to calm down to explain what is going on, you notice gang members assaulting several other teens and threatening you.

PROCEDURE:

Beginning at P1, with your hands on both shoulders of the Non-threat, on the signal, draw, and engage T1 and T2 on the move to P2 where you will engage T3 and T4. Then move to P3, engage T5. On the move to P4, activate the bear trap and engage T6; From cover at P4, engage T7.

SCORING: Unlimited

ROUND COUNT: 14

TARGETS: 07

DISTANCE: 15 yard minimum on steel activation popper

SCORED HITS: 2 Shots to each target

PENALTIES: Failure to engage T1, T2, & T6 on the move.

CONCEALMENT: Required

NOTES: T5 may only be engaged from P3. T1 and T2 caution of 180 rule.
